The course includes a Montessori Pre-primary (3-6) orientation, which is compulsory for all students, including those with a Montessori Pre-primary diploma.

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction is English. The students who want to submit their assignments and albums in Kannada should get special permission.

Course Fees

Registration fee Rs2000 Course Fee Rs60000

The course fee is payable in two payment options. Refer to the Course Fee Options document.

Other expenses

Students should budget for additional expenses related to the following:

- Travel expenses for observation and practice sessions.
- For Material making approximately Rs2000.
- Expenses related to printing some curriculum materials.
- Purchasing the required books.

Requirement for the Certification

- At least 90% attendance in theory, supervised practice classes
- Completion of two weeks of observation sessions and submission of observation reports
- submission of material files for the following areas: Languages,
 Arithmetic, Geometry, Botany, Zoology, History and Geography
- Successful completion of written and practice exams.

Audit the Course

This provides a flexible approach to understanding Montessori philosophy.

- At least 60% attendance in theory, supervised practice classes.
- Completion of two weeks of observation sessions and submission of observation reports.
- submission of at least two material files.
- Successful completion of written exams.

Application Process

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in any subject. Some exceptions can be made for people on a case-by-case basis. You need not have Montessori teaching experience or Montessori education to join the course.

Step 1

Step 2

- You will be invited to Vidyanjali Academy for Learning to get to know the training centre.
- Collect the application form by paying Rs.2000/-

Step 3

Submit the duly filled application to the office with the following documents:

- Curriculum Vitae with a photograph
- Proof of highest qualification
- Two reference letters
- One-page essay answering the questions: Why do you want to take the Montessori Teacher Training Course?
- Preferred payment option

Step 4

- Online interview
- Once all the documents are submitted and reviewed, you will be called for an online interview to talk about the course, answer your questions and ensure you have understood the course requirements.

Step 5

If you are accepted to the course, you will be expected to pay the course fee according to your chosen fee option and complete the admission process.
